Greetings Fellow Members,

The attached unaudited Balance Sheet and Income Statement accurately reflects the financial position of AIHA-RMS as of December 31, 2007.

As your Treasurer, I am pleased to report that last year was a good year financially for the organization. The financial success for the organization was supported by the Fall Technical Conference, Programs and your commitment as members to the organization. As a non-profit organization, financial success is demonstrated by matching our budget and ensuring the organization does not have a significant loss of revenue.

The financial performance for 2007 shows overall revenue was \$25,853.42. The balance of this total was made up by dues receipts of \$2,870.00, Fall Technical Conference receipts of \$21,371.13, meeting receipts of \$1,057.00 and interest income of \$555.29. Operating expenses totaled \$25,160.82 for the year with a net income of -\$1,307.40.

The organization is still very healthy from a balance sheet perspective. Our cash reserves balance at year end was \$45,496.39.

I look forward to keeping an open communication position with the membership regarding our overall financial performance in 2008. Please contact me if you have any questions regarding the finances of AIHA-RMS.
